

## Neighbor Parking Information

Residents living in the area bordered by Addison on the South, Racine/Clark to the West, Irving Park on the North and Wilton on the East have the opportunity to use one parking spot in the Chicago Cubs' Green Lot at 1126 W. Grace in accordance with the following outlined rules and regulations:

- 1) Neighbor parking pass applications can be obtained from the Chicago Cubs offices located at 3721 N. Clark.
- 2) Parking is available on Wrigley Field non-event days. An event day is any day where a major event is occurring at Wrigley Field (i.e. baseball games, concerts). Vehicles must be removed from the lot by 9 a.m., the morning of any event and can return to the lot two hours after the event has ended. Vehicles not removed in a timely matter may be towed at the automobile owner's expense. A schedule of events can be found at [cubs.com](http://cubs.com).
- 3) The Cubs will issue parking passes after an application is filled out, residence and City of Chicago vehicle sticker number is verified and the liability waiver is signed.
- 4) Notice: You are parking and leaving your vehicles at your own risk. Be sure to lock all doors and windows after removing any property or valuables from the vehicle. Chicago Cubs Baseball Club, LLC , and its parent entities, affiliates, officers, directors, members, managers, agents and employees are not liable for loss or damage to your vehicle or property left within.
- 5) Neighbor parking passes must be renewed yearly prior to Opening Day.
